NH | New Hampshire Clean Diesel Grant Program

ABOUT

The New Hampshire Clean Diesel Grant Program is funded by EPA through the Diesel Emissions Reduction Act (DERA) with additional funding from the New Hampshire VW Mitigation Trust. The goal of this grant program is to reduce the emissions from diesel engines in the State. Projects eligible for funding include vehicle and equipment replacement

ELIGIBLE PROJECT TYPES

Diesel heavy-duty vehicle replacement projects with electric vehicles.

Eligible costs may include the purchase and installation of 1 charging unit per vehicle, including the unit, charging cable, and the mount and/or pedestal.

MAXIMUM GRANT AMOUNT

Vehicle Replacement Project with ZEV replacement - Up to 45% maximum grant funding

FUNDING

\$650,000 available as of April 12, 2024.

SCRAPPAGE

Scrapping an existing heavy-duty diesel vehicle with **no restriction on Engine Model Year** is required to qualify.

EVALUATION

Competitive grant application.

APPLICATION TIMELINE

Round One project proposals are due on May 24, 2024.

If funding remains after Round One project selection, proposals submitted before August 2, 2024 will be evaluated as Round Two.

EXISTING VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

Existing vehicle must operate the majority of the time in New Hampshire, be fully operational, and in current service.

Existing vehicle must have at least 3 years of remaining useful life left and it must be in the owner's possession for at least 2 years preceding this replacement.

Existing vehicle must be used 7,000 miles per year for each of the 2 years preceding the replacement.

OPERATION REQUIREMENTS

Recipients must use the replacement unit for a period of no less than 5 years.

Quarterly and Annual Project Status Reports will be required from applicant.

COMMENTS

Payment made on reimbursement basis.
